Civil Service Exam NOTICE

The City of Warrensville Heights is accepting applications and test scores for the position of entry level police officer through the National Testing Network until March 8, 2025.

Those interested will need to go to [National Testing Network](#) to complete an application, view testing dates, times, locations and instructions for the entry exam and pay any required fees. The exam will be computer-administered and include subjects in reading, report writing and judgment. The entry exam must be taken and you must attain a test score of 70% or higher to be eligible for hire. A passing test result must be submitted to the City of Warrensville Heights no later than March 8, 2025. Test scores must be from exams taken through the National Testing Network on or after February 7, 2024.

Applicants must be 21 years of age and a maximum of 34 years of age at time of appointment, must be a high school graduate or have a GED, possess a valid Ohio driver's license and possess a valid Ohio Peace Officer Academy (OPOTA) certification.

A physical agility exam (additional fee required) must also be taken and passed by those who have passed the written test.
